Have you enjoyed a class, a course or a party at the village hall? The full capacity of the hall is 100, under normal conditions. It has an excellent kitchen, good heating and a small committee room for small meetings. It has a large car park and easy disabled access.

Currently there are a range of classes/activities which take place in the hall including Sing and Sign, Tai Chi, Step n' Grooves, Music Makers, indoor short mat bowls, karate etc.

The hall is managed by volunteers and we really need some more volunteers for the hall management committee. It is not an onerous task. We take bookings by phone, email and face to face, send out monthly invoices, manage the cleaning and upkeep of the hall, conduct risk assessments etc. We have 4-5 meetings a year to discuss plans for the future and we need YOUR input.
