Dear Cllr Duval

Thank you for your letter and emails. I am writing to ask when would it be possible to collect the rest of my personal belongings.

You cancelled my visit on Wednesday at 11am. I would like to arrange next week either Wednesday 18th October or 19th October at 10am to collect my things.

I realise that Councillor Maxwell collected some items, but I still would like to remove other items that I have purchased with my own money and empty my cupboards which contain items with which I did teas and coffee for user groups, eg, Under 13/15 girls' football, Under 13 boys, and Sargents.

I realise that you do not trust me to go on my own after 7 years, but maybe Councillor Maxwell could come with the Chairperson, Cllr Duval on Wednesday or Thursday.

I have informed the User Groups that I am no longer able to access the Pavilion, which they are quite sad about because I have been doing teas and coffee with Sargents for over 10 years, the Under 13 , 3 years, and the Girls' teams this season.

As a member of the public, I am sad that the Parish Council have kept the gates locked from the public, who had used it for it for the past 15 years. People run here,

visit the memorial seat to the young 3 year old child who lost his life on the field, and others for a walk. I do not see this at your other open spaces.

I would also like to point out that Alfie, who has been working at the Pavilion for over 2 years, as a cleaner, could have a case against the Parish Council for dismissal.

You may considered this and pay him according.

Lastly, I would like my letter printed with your minutes for others to see how the Parish Council operate in Islip.
