Sports field hire charges for bookings made after 1ST APRIL 2024: Prices subject to 20% VAT, if they are NOT sports based.

Pavilion:

- o Hourly rate £15.00 per hour but Minimum charge for any booking £20. Block booking of 10 sessions or more, or for regular use for 6 months–20% discount. Field and changing rooms.
- o Pitches for games £45 for 11v11 pitch, £35 for 9V9 pitch
- o Training sessions £20 per session
- o Cricket same as last year, as they do their own ground maintainence
- Rounders £16 per session (20% discount agreed due to it being a village team and booked 5 months in advance)
- o Use of Field/changing rooms for a day (eg soccer school) £85
- o Sole use of Field and Pavilion for a day £ 150

Any bookings made up to 1st April – old charges. Any bookings after 1st April – new charge. All users will be informed..
