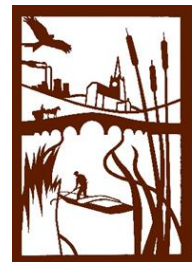

24/09	HIGHWAYS AND FOOTPATHS <ul style="list-style-type: none">progress in regards to flooding on Toll Bar Road was noted, and this issue is being resolved over the coming months. Drayton Estate are being very cooperative in clearing the culverts and hedges (after bird nesting) and NNC have agreed to cut back overgrowing trees on Kettering Road to allow equipment to access the ditch and hedge.

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	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • progress on fence repairs at Mill House noted and the owner of the fence has agreed to make repairs. The environment agency has also been informed. • Flooding of Mill Lane was noted, and the drain at the top will be reported to NNC • Cllr Sobey reported on the meeting with Kier group and described the circumstances in which Kier currently work– see annex 1. • Councils voiced ongoing concerns regarding the state of the roads in the village and are frustrated that some areas have been repaired whilst others haven't ie. Road into Islip off the A6116 (Lowick road end) repaired but not Chapel Hill.
24/10	<p>RECREATION GROUND- Rec checks received.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Repairs have been carried out, and Cllr Taylor will check equipment before forthcoming ROSPA inspection. • Clerk to contact Thrapston town council in regards to regular refuse collection from the Recreation Ground.
